Zoom in on stunning star clusters, nebulae and distant galaxies. Travel through time and see the sky as it appeared in the distant past or far into the future.

Sky Zoo

Recommended for ages 3-4

A great introduction for young children as we enjoy a fun romp through the sky. Learn about the Sun and Moon and look for the animals hidden in the star patterns.

Length: 20-30 minutes

Recommended for ages 4 and up

Take an exciting trip through our solar system where we visit the moon and all planets.

Length: 40 minutes

Recommended for ages 4 and up

Enjoy a tour of our local night sky. Learn some of the prominent seasonal constellations, which planets are visible and see what wonders they sky has to offer this month.

Length: 40 minutes

The First Heroes

Recommended for ages 6 and up

Learn about some of the great heroes from Greek mythology like Hercules and Perseus. Hear their stories and discover how to find them in the night sky.

Length: 40 minutes

Exploring the Universe

Recommended for ages 9 and up

Investigate some of the bright constellations in our night sky and hear their stories. Take a tour through our galaxy and see star clusters, stellar nurseries and the remains of exploded stars.

Length: 40 minutes



Cost

Each show is \$120

Please note there is an additional \$70 set up fee for the first show only. A mileage fee will apply for locations outside of Winnipeg.

The maximum capacity for the dome is about **30 people**. The planetarium is a large structure that needs to be set up in an indoor space measuring at least **20 feet by 20 feet** with a **ceiling height** of at least **12 feet**.
